Committee to Select Discussion Question

The continued success of the tape-recorded panel discussion contest has led the Board of Control to decide to continue the contest as a major association activity, with no changes in the rules followed in 1955. November 5 was set as the deadline date for registering for this event. This represents a later date than last year, and was set to allow all member schools ample time to put to use the materials available to them after their dues for 1956-7 have been received. The question for discussion will be determined in late summer or early fall by a committee consisting of Professors Brembeck, Brockhaus, Haberman and Weaver, and will be announced in the September News Letter. will pertain to the agricultural policy problem area.

A New Service to Debate Schools

Each year some of our debate schools find the district contest providing them with their first inter-school competition of the year. In some instances, the lack of previous competition is a case of being unaware of who is sponsoring a practice tournament and when it is being held.

In the September News Letter we would like to publish a list of the practice tournaments scheduled in Wisconsin. This, of course, requires your assistance. Would you take a few minutes to send us the date of your contest, the style of debating used, and the divisions (A, B or C) which you will include? Those of you whose tournaments are on the same weekend each year could be sure of being listed in the September News Letter by sending us the date as soon as possible.

Debaters Must Be Certified for Each Round

A situation at the state debate tournament brought about Board clarification of some ambiguity in the supplementary rules for discussion and debate. Standing Rule III; 3, 4, and 6 has been repealed and replaced with the following:

Each school shall certify in advance of the contest a team for each of the rounds of the contest. This team shall consist of two affirmative and two negative debaters and may also have one or two alternates. If two, one must be designated affirmative alternate and one negative alternate. The alternates shall attend only those debates in which their team is participating. He may not participate in the debate in any way except in case of illness of a debater. No debater shall participate on both sides in the same debate contest.

Wisconsin High School Forensic Association

This does not constitute any basic procedural change. What it does mean, in effect, is that any school desiring to use more than four debaters in the course of the state tournament may do so, if the coach has designated with the advance registration which two are debating on which side for each of the four rounds. A student listed as a debater in one round may be an alternate in another round. An appropriate debate contest registration blank will be designed for the coming year.

Speech Institutes Reach Record Number of Students

More students from more schools than ever before in the history of the Association took advantage of the fine speech institutes set up by the state colleges and the WHSFA in the past school year. The eight institutes held this year (three less than last year) attracted 3,348 students from 183 high schools. Such success was not to be denied, as the Board voted to continue the program again next year.

Your district chairman is your contact man for the forensic institute you attend. He'll be meeting with the college personnel in your area soon to set up next year's institute. If you have some ideas on how the institute can be improved to better meet your needs, why not drop him a line today. We hope to announce the schedule for these institutes in the September News Letter.

Six Schools Now Needed to Hold District Drama and Debate Contests

After a year's trial with the new contest regulation pertaining to the number of schools required for the holding of a district drama or district debate contest, the Board of Control has ruled that unless at least six schools are entered in a district contest the schools in that district may proceed directly to the sectional contest. There was a strong feeling that four or even five schools did not seem enough to warrant holding a contest where all 4-2 schools and/or the three highest schools and all tied with them would, in any case, proceed to the next contest. Thus, Standing Rule I, 7, h will be changed accordingly for 1956-57.

New Speech Contest Well Received

"Definitely continue this event." Such was the overwhelming reaction of judges, coaches, students and the Board of Control to the interpretative reading contest which became a part of the WHSFA Speech program this year. You will recall that this event was begun with the idea that it was more typical of the demands of adult life than the memorized events. Material used will again include prose or poetry.

An equally enthusiastic reception was given to the choice of material used in extemporaneous reading this year. The result: narrative poetry will again be used and our speech contestants will again have an opportunity to become better acquainted with that important but often neglected field of literature.

State Speech Contest

This year 989 students received A ratings in the district contests which qualified them to enter the state contest. Of that number 969 actually participated. 464 received "A" awards, 451 received "B" awards and 54 received "C" awards.

The <u>September News Letter</u> will list titles of the selections used. Medals won at the state contest have been mailed out and all schools should have received them by now.
