Board and Association Meetings

In November, the Board of Control and the Association will hold meetings in Milwaukee. These are held at the time of the Wisconsin Education Ass'n meeting. Member schools are invited to send representatives to our Ass'n meeting to present any problems.

Drama

Drama work should begin early in the school year since the name of the play to be used in the drama contest must be registered with the secretary-treasurer on or before October 15th. A new list of APPROVED PLAYS 1952 (Gray Cover) is being sent to each member school with this News Letter. Please discard all old play lists you may have in your library as some of the plays have been discontinued and some new ones have been added. Do not use any list which does not have Wisconsin High School Forensic Association--1952, on the cover.

We can not stress too often or too much the importance of selecting a play long before it is to be produced. Selections made under pressure, or under requirement to meet a deadline are rarely good ones. (See latest dates on News Letter cover.)

New Sectional Chairman

Neil D. Greene, teacher of speech and drama at Juscoda High School was appointed chairman of the Southern Section. He succeeds Mr. A. J. Kriewald of Platteville high school, who was forced to resign because of ill health. (See Resolution on page 6.)

The Association welcomes Mr. Greene to membership on the Board of Control.

Lines of Communication

The Board instructed the secretary-treasurer that all communications to the member schools be sent to the principal with the request that they be referred to the appropriate coaches. Referendum questionnaires should contain a line for the signatures of both the principal and the coach. Referenda on debate questions should be sent to all schools that checked debate on the registration card.

Referendum on Debate Procedure

The Board approved a request of coaches attending the State Debate Contest that a referendum be held this spring to discover if the debating schools

- (a) wish a committee to frame a specific debate question within the national problem area and announce it in the November News Letter or
- (b) wish to wait until January 1st and accept the specific debate question as worded by the NUPA COMMITTEE.

Plaques Instead of Banners

Attractive plaques will replace the familiar banners as first place awards in the State Drama and Debate contests this coming year.

Change in Extemp Reading

The subject for extemporaneous reading for 1952-53 shall be North American folklore in prose. This action was taken after hearing the report and recommendations of Miss Nelson's committee on activities, and after very thorough discussion. It should provide a fresh and interesting experiment in our contest program. A committee shall prepare a basic bibliography of folklore material to be used by the schools in their initial preparation and early contests. The committee shall solicit contributions of local folklore from the members of the Association and the people of the state. The committee shall select, cut, and have mimeographed a set of selections of North American folklore--in prose, which shall be used in all league and district contests and in the state contest. The procedure from here on shall be identical with present practice in extempore reading.

Other Activities the Same

After carefully considering various suggestions and recommendations for changing other activities in the contest structure, the Board felt that the present activities provide the breadth of experiences necessary to appeal to all members of the Association and decided to continue the rest of the program as it is now being conducted.

The 1952 State Drama Contest will be held in the new college theatre at Wisconsin State College, Eau Claire, on December 13. This break from precedent was made after much discussion by the Board of Control, as to whether or not it should accept the kind invitation of Mr. Earl Kjer, to help dedicate the new building in this way. The Board felt that, all factors being considered, this was the right thing to do this year.
