PART I: THE BOARD OF CONTROL

May Board Meeting

The regular meeting of the WHSFA Board of Control was held on May 6-7, 1976, at the Holiday Inn in Stevens Point.

Agenda Item 1

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by the chair, George Buckingham. Members present, in addition to Buckingham, were:

Frank Cirilli, Bernard Bennett, R. M. Duesterbeck, Wayne Gustafson, Ed Sievers, William O'Brien, Dennis Bonikowske, Richard Cross, James Highland, Raymond Behnke, Robert Beaver, and William Hintz. Also in attendance were Advisor-in-Speech Pauline Isaacson, Advisor-in-Drama Calvin Quayle, and Secretary-Treasurer Larry E. Larmer. (The meeting recessed at 9:00 p.m. on May 6 and re-convened at 9:30 a.m. on May 7. All those present on May 6, with the exception of Calvin Quayle, were in attendance on May 7.)

Agenda Item 2

Frank Cirilli moved that the minutes of the November 4-5, 1975, Board meeting be approved as distributed. Motion passed.

Agenda Item 3

Retiring Board member James Highland was presented with a Certificate of Recognition for his three year's service. Calvin Quayle was presented with a Certificate of Recognition for Meritorious Service for his three year's service as advisor-in-drama.

Agenda Item 4a

R. M. Duesterbeck reported on the December meeting of the NUEA Committee on Discussion and Debate.

Agenda Item 4b

The Secretary-Treasurer reported that the WHSFA debate resolution for the 1976-77 school year would be: "RESOLVED: That a comprehensive program of penal reform should be adopted throughout the US."

Agenda Item 4c

The Secretary-Treasurer reported that the site of the 1977 State Debate Tournament would be the University of Wisconsin-Stevens Point.

Agenda Item 4d

The Secretary-Treasurer reported that a combined calendar of activities for the WHSFA, WIAA, WSMA, and WTA would again be prepared and distributed over the summer.

Agenda Item 4e

The Secretary-Treasurer reported on the Platteville and Eau Claire workshops jointly sponsored by WHSFA and UWEXT.

Agenda Item 4f

The Secretary-Treasurer reported on the State Office's finances to date for the current fiscal year. At the request of the Secretary-Treasurer, Buckingham appointed the following committee to review the State Office's financial structure: Cirilli (chairman), Vergin, and Duesterbeck.

Agenda Item 4g

The Secretary-Treasurer presented a membership report for the 1975-76 year. It was noted that the total membership was 470 schools, the same as the previous year.

Agenda Item 4h

The Secretary-Treasurer reported on participation in contests at the state level for 1975-76.

Agenda Item 4i

The Secretary-Treasurer reminded district and sectional chairpersons to submit financial reports to the State Office around July 1.

Agenda Item 4j

The Secretary-Treasurer reminded Board members to submit expense reports for the current meeting.

Agenda Item 4k

The Secretary-Treasurer reported on the progress of pending Board elections.

Agenda Item 4l

William Hintz reported for the ad hoc committee on JR high school activities. The committee recommended that three JR high forensic festivals be conducted on March 19, 1976. Details regarding fees, categories, and exact locations to be worked out at another time. Vergin moved passage of the committee's recommendation. Motion passed.

Agenda Item 4m

Hintz reported for the Contest Study Committee.

- (1) The committee recommended adding as general rule 14: "While the use of a prompter in WHSFA contest events is discouraged because it may detract from the overall effectiveness of a presentation, the use of a prompter is not prohibited by rule."

Beaver moved acceptance of the committee's recommendation. Motion passed.

- (2) The committee recommended that the practice of using five judges for state Drama be continued and that the Association not pursue the suggestion of naming first place winners in the Drama contest.
- (3) The committee recommended that Vergin and Bonikowske conduct an experimental novice debate tournament in the Stevens Point area in the fall of 1976. Other plans for a State Novice Tournament are delayed pending advice from the WDCA.
- (4) Hintz moved that Storytelling and Demonstration Speaking be added as permanent Spring Speech categories. Motion passed.
- (5) Hintz reported that the committee recommended that no further action be taken on the Burke proposal. The recommendation was based on the information received from district coaches' meetings which indicated almost unanimous negative reaction to the proposal. Sievers moved adoption of the committee's recommendation. Motion passed.
- (6) The committee recommended adoption of the Interpreter's Theatre rules as drafted by Calvin Quayle with a slight modification of rule 7. Cross moved adoption of the committee's recommendation. Motion passed.
- (7) The committee recommended dropping Public Address as a category in Spring Speech. The Board did not accept the recommendation.
- (8) The committee recommended eliminating the rule permitting one or more questions by the judge at the end of a Demonstration or Extemporaneous speech. Beaver moved to accept the committee's recommendation. Motion passed.
- (9) Hintz reported that the committee had received a request to provide medals for all participants at the State Speech Contest. The committee's recommendation was not to change the award structure. Behnke moved to accept the committee's recommendation. The motion passed.
- (10) The committee recommended to change Declamation so that the material in this category will be limited to published plays, or movie, T.V., or radio scripts. Each selection must have two or more characters. Beaver moved to accept the committee's recommendation. Motion passed. (NOTE: Subsequent to this action was a negative reaction by the WFCA; through a telephone poll of Board members, it was decided to postpone this action pending a referendum of coaches of member schools.)
- (11) The committee recommended that Storytelling be limited to children's literature and that an extemporaneous mode of delivery be required. Cirilli moved that the committee's recommendation be accepted. Motion passed. (NOTE: Subsequent to this action was a negative reaction by the WFCA; through a telephone poll of

Board members, it was decided to postpone this action pending a referendum of coaches of member schools.)

Agenda Item 5a

The Secretary-Treasurer proposed a five-year calendar reflecting changes in district and state Debate dates and dates for Board meetings.

Agenda Item 5b

Buckingham appointed himself auditor of the State Office books.

Agenda Item 5c

The Board selected Professor Thomas Goltry of University of Wisconsin-Platteville as advisor-in-drama for a three-year term.

Agenda Item 5d

The Secretary-Treasurer moved to eliminate the Newsletter issued after State Drama. Motion passed.

Agenda Item 5e

- (1) The Board discussed a communication received by the Secretary-Treasurer from the Wisconsin Association of School Boards and made recommendations to the Secretary-Treasurer regarding his appearance before a committee of that group.
- (2) Cross moved that the Fall, 1976, Board meeting be held in Stevens Point and that the Spring, 1977, meeting be held in Eau Claire. Motion passed.
- (3) The Board discussed a letter from Art Mc Million of Eau Claire Memorial High School regarding judging at the State Debate Tournament. The Secretary-Treasurer was instructed to respond to Mr. Mc Million and incorporate as many of his suggestions as possible.

Non-WHSFA Events

Several Wisconsin schools participated beyond the state level in National Forensic League and National Catholic Forensic League competition. We are pleased to report their achievements here. The WHSFA extends its thanks to James Copeland of Milwaukee Marquette for supplying information.

PART V: PROFESSIONAL INTEREST

"Television Debate Series"

Several Madison-area WHSFA debate schools will cooperate with Madison's educational television station (WHA-TV, Channel 21) by participating in a series of televised debates during the 1976-77 school year.

The debates, broadcast each week on Saturdays beginning on October 9, will be on topics of general public interest as determined by Channel 21 and public affairs ascertainment efforts. Although the exact debate propositions are not yet specified, there will be four resolutions debated in each of the following general problem areas: Cost of Living, Education, Government, Transportation, Employment, Taxes, Community Growth, Recreation and Entertainment.

Those schools indicating a desire to participate include: Madison Memorial, Madison East, Platteville, Mc Farland, Janesville Craig, and Janesville Parker. Other Madison area schools are expected to join in as the series gets underway.

The purpose of the debates is to explore issues rather than to win decisions. Accordingly, all debates, conducted in a modified Lincoln-Douglas format, will be nondecision.

At present, plans are to broadcast the debates only in the Madison area. However, it is possible that they may be included in the programming efforts of other ETV stations in the state.

Larry Larmer, Secretary-Treasurer of the WHSFA, will be coordinating and moderating the debate series.
