#### PART I: THE BOARD OF CONTROL

#### May Board Meeting

The regular meeting of the WHSFA Board of Control was held on May 2-3, 1974, at the Holiday Inn #1 in Madison. Abstracted from the minutes of that meeting are the following items:

Reported:

By the secretary-treasurer that the balloting process for the 1974-75 WHSFA debate proposition had resulted in the selection of the following resolution:

RESOLVED: That campaign funds for all federal elective offices should be provided exclusively by the federal government.

Received:

A request from Mr. Arthur Krival, Director of Communication Programming for University of Wisconsin-Extension, that the WHSFA increase its annual payment to University Extension. Chairman of the Board, Mr. Buckingham, appointed a committee to propose a response to Mr. Krival's request. The Committee will report at the Fall Board meeting.

Recommended:

The use of referees' committees at WHSFA contests to handle apparent rule violations or misinterpretations.

Recommended:

That WHSFA drama judges should not be employed for more than one contest level in a given year.

Passed:

A new drama rule: "A brief written introduction shall be sent to contest managers at district, sectional, and state levels to help both judges and audiences in viewing the plays."

Passed:

A new debate tournament system which would provide for naming both a state two-man and state four-man champion. Specific provisions are:

- 1. All district lines remain the same.
- 2. All sectional competition is abolished.
- 3. All district rules remain the same.
- A four-wins and two-losses record, or better, in the district tournament qualifies a school to attend the state tournament.
- 5. On the state entry form, the coach must declare whether the school will enter two two-person teams, prepare to debate both sides, or one four-person team with students remaining on one side.
- The winner of the two-person division and the winner of the four-person division will each be regarded as state champions of their respective divisions.

Passed:

The following general rule addition:

"District and sectional chairmen and/or managers of WHSFA contests have the right to require that those schools wishing to enter WHSFA tournaments and contests honor reasonable deadlines for the receipt of eligibility-registration forms. Entering schools have the burden of proof in demonstrating compliance with the deadline. Accordingly, it is recommended that entering schools submit their eligibility-registration forms by certified mail. It is further recommended that district or sectional chairmen or contest managers confirm entries as they are received."

Passed:

The following reforms in the State Debate Tournament:

 There shall be four preliminary rounds at the State Debate Tournament.

'Byes' shall be eliminated from the elimination bracket at the State Debate Tournament.

 The criteria for seeding teams in the elimination bracket shall be, in order: (a) win-loss record; (b) combined speaker points; (c) team points; (d) opponents' records.

 The secretary-treasurer shall be authorized to seek sites other than Madison for the State Debate Tournament.

Passed:

A rule change allowing each school <u>25 entries</u> in the subdistrict speech contest. No more than four entries per category would be allowed. Each Play-Acting group would count as two <u>entries</u>, thus only two Play-Acting groups would be permitted.

Passed:

Two additional Spring Speech categories--Storytelling and Demonstration Speaking.

Passed:

Two topic areas for Public Address.

Recommended:

That each district conduct a judging clinic in the fall of each year.

Approved:

A five-year calendar with changes for 1975 and 1976 providing that District Debate Tournaments be held on the dates on which sectionals were previously scheduled.

Approved:

The secretary-treasurer's suggestion that Mr. William O'Brien of Pulaski be asked to serve out the remainder of resigning Board member James Trachte's term as Chairman of the Green Bay District.

Passed:

The following Standing Rule addition:

"A standing committee, named the Contest Study Committee, shall be charged with the responsibility of reviewing matters concerning contest rules and management. The Contest Study Committee shall be composed of the chairperson of the Board or his designate, sectional chairpersons, the advisor-indrama, the advisor-in-speech, a representative of the Wisconsin Debate Coaches Association, a representative of the Wisconsin Forensic Coaches Association, and the WHSFA secretary-treasurer. The Committee chairperson shall be appointed annually by the chairperson of the Board of Control. The Committee shall meet prior to the semi-annual Board meetings and shall report to each Board meeting."

#### 1974 Elections

During May of 1974, elections were held for four WHSFA district chairmanships and one sectional chairmanship. Elected to three-year terms on the Board of Control were:

#### Board Resignation

Mr. James Trachte has resigned from the Board of Control effective at the end of the 1973-74 school year. Mr. William O'Brien has accepted the appointment to complete the last year of Mr. Trachte's term.

In the spring of 1975, the State Office will conduct elections for the chairmanship of the Central Section, the Green Bay District, the Oshkosh District, the Platteville District, and the Whitewater District.

#### Non-WHSFA Events

Several Wisconsin schools participated beyond the state level in forensic competition. We are pleased to report their achievements here. The WHSFA extends its thanks to James Copeland of Marquette for supplying information on these national tournaments.

The National Catholic Forensic League tournament was held in May, 1974, in New Orleans. Wisconsin schools participating were Brookfield Central, Lake Geneva Badger, Kenosha St. Mary's, Milwaukee Marquette, Milwaukee Pius XI, and Sheboygan North. Milwaukee Marquette placed second in sweepstakes and took first place in debate with a team composed of James Fleissner and Craig Mullen, both juniors. Other individual achievements were Marc Bassewitz of Sheboygan North, second in Boys' Extemporaneous Speaking; Matt Liedle, Marquette, third place in Oratory; and Cary Pfeffer, Marquette, finals in Oratory.

The <u>National Forensic League</u> tournament was held at Southern Methodist University in Dallas on June 17-20, 1974. Four hundred seventy-two students from 49 states participated.

Milwaukee Marquette attained another record accomplishment by winning the NFL sweepstake for a <u>fourth</u> consecutive year.

Two Marquette debate teams (Patrick Mayer, James Jensen and Tom McCarthy, Bruce Arnold) reached the semi-final round in debate-a record achievement. Patrick Mayer also took third place in Extemporaneous Speaking.

Other Wisconsin participants were: Brookfield Central--Regina O'Conner, Student Congress (Dru Munson, coach); Delavan-Darien--Stephen Kocs, octafinalist in Boys' Extemporaneous Speaking (Walter Daumler, coach); Durand--Ruth Brenner, octafinalist in Girls' Extemporaneous Speaking (R. M. Duesterbeck, coach); Marquette--James Dawe, octafinalist in Boys' Extemporaneous Speaking, Matt Liedle, Oratory, Jeff Ignaszak, Oratory, Tom Riehle, Dramatic Interpretation, Cary Pfeffer, Dramatic Interpretation (James Copeland, coach).

Pictured above are the twenty-five high school student participants in the forensic workshop held during June on the campus of University Wisconsin-Whitewater. Also pictured are the workshop's major instructors, Professors Edna Sorber and Richard Haven, and the several graduate students who assisted them.

The workshop was a cooperative venture involving, in addition to University of Wisconsin-Whitewater, University of Wisconsin-Extension and the WHSFA. The idea came from the teachers and students of WHSFA member schools who felt that the Association ought to do more in the way of providing and promoting such educational opportunities for its student participants. The Department of Speech Communication, University of Wisconsin-Whitewater enthusiastically agreed to cooperate and Dr. Thomas McLeRoy's Office of Continuing Education provided invaluable guidance and assistance.

Fortunately, Professors Sorber and Haven were available to serve as the major instructors. Professor Sorber is extremely well known for her involvement in forensics, not only in Wisconsin but throughout the nation. She has served the Association as a consistently reliable and willing judge and supervised the undergraduate and graduate training of numerous Wisconsin high school directors of forensics. Professor Haven is a relative newcomer to the state, but is rapidly becoming a favorite among Wisconsin's high school forensic partici-

pants. He has finished his second year as director of individual events in University of Wisconsin-Whitewater's forensic program, and is a most committed and creative teacher of individual events participation.

The objective of the workshop was not to develop polished contestants, but rather, to provide an additional educationally sound forensic experience. Accordingly, each student received instruction in basic principles of public speaking and oral interpretation. Also, each student received intensive laboratory training in one speaking event and one interpretive event. Throughout the workshop, extensive use was made of University of Wisconsin-Whitewater's video tape and listening lab facilities. The University made two hours of college credit available to participants on an additional fee basis.

Overail, the workshop seemed extremely well received by its participants. Typical of the responses on the student evaluation forms was the following: "I am really going to hate to leave because I have made a lot of new friends. All of us became one big family. I hope to be coming back next year. Mr. Haven and Miss Sorber did a great job!"

Since there was unanimous agreement among participants that a similar workshop ought to be offered again, plans are now underway to provide a similar offering for the summer of 1975.
