BILL HINTZ

Most of us knew Bill Hintz in one way or another. If all of our individual lives have not yet been changed since his death, they soon will be.

It is incredible to look around this room tonight and not see Bill and Ginny sitting somewhere out there. We can look ahead and realize that it will be equally incredible not to have Bill with us at all those festivals, contests, board and committee meetings he ordinarily would attend. We can look as far ahead as two years from tonight--when Bill was scheduled to preside over this Association at this annual convention--and realize he will not be here.

There are many reasons to feel sad when a friend dies. Perhaps the best reason of all is that we genuinely miss the person. We will have many occasions to miss Bill in the near future. It is particularly ill-fitting that Bill's not here tonight--for this was his convention. He was the second vice-president of this Association, and it was his duty to plan these two days. One of Bill's very last acts was to nail down our program content.

Once, when the Executive Committee was working on this event, we hit on the theme of "family communication." I saw Bill becoming very enthusiastic about that theme, and his enthusiasm is reflected in several of our programs and in the remarks of our keynote speaker. Bill was the consummate family man. Bill travelled often, and whenever possible Ginny or one or more of the children would go along. Bill cared about his family--what was happening in their lives was very important to his life.

Bill treated us like family, too. I do not mean that in any cornball sense, that Bill loved us all like brothers and sisters. I mean, literally, that Bill treated us like family--and we are better off for it. Bill was responsible to us as one family member is to another. Bill seemed to understand better than anyone I know that the common goals and objectives of the members of this profession will be realized only through volunteerism. Bill was always ready to respond, to volunteer, to do his share.

Just as families squabble, we often disagree over who should judge forensic activities, whether speech activities ought to be more or less competitive, whether interpersonal communication is more "basic" than public speaking, and so forth. Bill never permitted his own concern for the outcome of any such issue to overshadow his regard for the people involved. Bill knew that the people who are here tonight are the same people who were here last year and the years before and will be here next year and the years after. Bill knew that the work we have in common will get done because of the people and their commitments--not because any issue is resolved one way as opposed to another.

Bill treated us as whole people, not just as roles. As we work together it is easy to respond to one another solely in terms of narrow parts of each other--as teacher, as student, as colleague--and to forget that there is much more to each of us. Bill was not having any of that. Bill wished to devote those "after hours" conversations to finding out more about who we were and to share who he was. He provided a way for us to enrich our professional relationships.

Bill respected us. We have all tried in many ways these past few weeks to pay our last respects to Bill--the wake, the funeral, the memorial resolutions, the scholarship funds, and even these brief remarks, but it is all quite frustrating. We pay our last respects to a person the last time we see that person alive. And Bill, I think, had that understanding--and he treated us accordingly--as though each time he saw us, it may be for the last time.

We are going to miss Bill in many ways and on many occasions--but if we are smart we will learn from his example.

(These remarks were delivered by Larry Larmer at the Wisconsin Communication Association Convention held in Madison on May 4, 1979.)

PART I: THE BOARD OF CONTROL

Minutes of Board of Control Meeting
Inn on the Park, Madison
May 3-4, 1979

Agenda Item 1

The meeting was called to order by the Chair, George Buckingham, at 7:15 PM, May 3. Members present, in addition to Buckingham, were: Armstrong, Beaver, Bennett, Copeland (representing Father Gerald Goetz), Duesterbeck, Goltry (Advisor in Drama), Isaacson (Advisor in Speech), Mickolajak, Ott, Schumacher, Settle (Advisor in Debate), Snyder, Steinhorst, Vergin, Palm (Assistant Secretary-Treasurer), Larmer (Secretary-Treasurer). Also present was Merlin Kilty representing the Wisconsin Association of School Boards.

The meeting was recessed at 10:00 and reconvened at 9:15 AM on May 4. All those in attendance on May 3 were in attendance on May 4 except for Larmer. Robert Scott also joined the meeting on Friday morning.

Larmer introduced Pete Settle, the Advisor in Debate, and recognized Mr. Kilty's attendance representing the Wisconsin Association of School Boards.

Agenda Item 2

Bennett moved that the minutes of the October 24-25, 1978 Board meeting be approved as distributed. Motion passed.

Agenda Item 3A

Larmer noted that Arthur Krival, representing the University Wisconsin-Extension, would not be in attendance at this meeting as scheduled.

Agenda Item 3E

The membership report noted a net loss of five schools for the 1978-79 school year. Milwaukee school closings account for some of these changes.

Agenda Item 3F

Debate participation has grown after the 1974-75 rule changes and since that time have remained consistent.

Student participation has remained high in Speech.

Agenda Item 3G

Larmer reminded District and Sectional Chairs to submit financial reports.

Agenda Item 3H

Larmer presented the revised budget for 1979-80 as well as the projected figures through 1982.

Mickolajak moved to accept the figures as presented. Motion passed unanimously. Bonding insurance was also discussed. Vergin moved it be discontinued. Motion passed.

Agenda Item 3I

Larmer reminded Board members to submit travel expense reports for the current meeting.

Agenda Item 3J

Larmer reported on balloting for District Chair positions in Superior, Stevens Point, Kenosha, and the Northern Sectional Chair.

The election procedure was reviewed. Primary balloting is to be completed by May 10.

Agenda Item 4A

Larmer introduced a Memorial Resolution for Bill Hintz. Vergin moved that the Association extend a William Hintz award. The motion passed. A committee of Bob Scott, Bob Beaver, and Edsel Vergin was appointed to develop an award, criteria, and method of presentation. A School Achievement Award Proposal was given to the Committee for their consideration.

Agenda Item 4B

Larmer presented names for consideration to fill the unexpired term of Bill Hintz, Southern Section Chair. It was noted this term expires in 1980. Vergin moved to appoint Robert Scott of Delavan-Darien High School. The motion passed unanimously.

Agenda Item 4C-1

Palm presented the five-year calendar with revisions regarding Speech dates. Vergin moved to accept. Motion passed.

Revision on Board meeting dates occurred at Friday's meeting. The fall Board meeting will be October 30-31 in Madison. The spring Board meeting will be May 1-2 in Stevens Point.

Agenda Item 4C-2

Larmer will determine whose turn it is to do the combined calendar for 1979-80. He will also ask for a pledge of behavior to respect dates of each other from the various groups represented in the calendar.

Agenda Item 4D

Buckingham appointed himself as the Board auditor.

Additional Items

Larmer will find one-year replacement for Settle, Advisor in Debate, while he is attending school.

Buckingham appointed Duesterbeck Contest Study Committee Chair.

Larmer presented letter from Shirley Johnson, University Wisconsin-Extension librarian, regarding Play Lists. It was decided to ask her to revise the current Play List and also to mention in the Teachers Manual that Play Lists are available from the Extension Library.

Agenda Item 3B

Duesterbeck reported on the NUEA Committee on Discussion and Debate meeting held in Tampa, Florida last December.

Agenda Item 3C

Duesterbeck announced that the 1979-80 Debate resolution would be: RESOLVED: That the United States should significantly change its foreign trade policies.

Minnesota and Iowa have reported that they will be using this same resolution.

Agenda Item 3D

Palm reported on the progress of the Junior High Committee. It was noted that the next meeting of the advisory group is scheduled for Saturday, May 19, at Howard Johnson's on East Washington Avenue in Madison.

Agenda Item 3K

Palm reported for the Contest Study Committee.

Goltry reported on Drama reform proposal voting. An ungraded subdistrict festival and recommendations for advancement replacing A's, B's, and C's, along with the identification of goals and objectives, are major revisions. Title of contest changed to Theatre Festival. Plaques will be metallic for Finalist and red for All State. Certificates will be used for Outstanding Merit in Acting or Directing. Vergin moved to put on two-year trial basis. Motion passed.

Committee reported on Wally Daumler's recommendation regarding Public Address revisions and questions for next year. Vergin moved to drop Public Address from categories of competition, effective 1979-80. Motion passed. Board requested this item be placed on District meeting agenda next spring.

Committee recommended no action to change rules in Prose/Poetry regarding changing of selections. Board concurred.

Committee recommended Play Acting and Interpreter's Theatre be counted as single entries and that a school may enter 2 Play Acting groups and 2 Interpreter's Theatre groups for a total of 4 of the 25 allowable entries if they so desire. Board accepted recommendation.

The Committee recommended re-writing Rule 3 of Interpreter's Theatre to include a statement allowing schools to provide their own stools and music stands. Board accepted revision.

The Committee recommended a survey of member schools regarding the desirability of changing rules regarding the District Contest from a one-round to a three-round event.

Vergin moved that the Board should go on record as approving the concept and that the State Office should include an informational letter explaining this possibility in the material sent to the member schools in the fall. It should also be an agenda item for the spring coaches meetings. The motion passed.

The Committee recommended a survey of the membership regarding suggested changes in the Storytelling category. Ott moved that this be done. Motion passed.

Committee recommendation to give A certificates at District Speech Contests was approved by the Board. It was also noted that pins and medals were not to be given by any District.

No action was recommended on changing time for spring Speech to the fall. The Board agreed.

Committee recommended a list of judges be compiled by the State Office for District Chair use. The Board recommended no action at this time.

Committee recommendation of no action regarding further judge selection procedures for State Debate was accepted by the Board.

No action regarding rules concerning alternates listening to rounds of debate was recommended by the Committee and accepted by the Board.

Larmer was asked to draw up a bad-weather policy for District use by the Committee and the Board.

Committee recommendation to allow for alternating four-speaker and two-speaker starting times at State Debate was accepted contingent on availability of rooms.

Committee recommended no action regarding additional awards in Debate. Bennett recommended a four and five place (Honorable Mention) for four-speaker teams be added and that those team members also receive pins. Motion passed.

No action on changing the two-speaker division to a six-round tournament was recommended by the Committee and accepted by the Board.

The Committee recommended allowing a 3-0 half of a four-speaker district unit to attend the State two-speaker tournament. Beaver made a motion to reject this proposal. Motion passed.

Additional Items

The Board requested copies of the WHSFA award proposal be sent with the minutes (see attachment). Bennett requested that Debate districts be clearly drawn to avoid split entries. This will be on the fall agenda.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:50 on May 4.

1979 Elections

During April and May of 1979, elections were held for three district chairpersons and one sectional chairperson: Kenosha District, Reverend Gerald Goetz, Milwaukee Marquette High School; Stevens Point District, Mr. Edsel Vergin, Mosinee High School; Superior District, Ms. Karen Monahan, Superior SR High School; and for the Northern Section, Mr. Richard Duesterbeck, Durand High School.

1980 Elections

In the spring of 1980, the State Office will conduct elections for chairpersons of the Eau Claire District, La Crosse District, Milwaukee District, and the River Falls District. Mr. Robert Scott, Delavan-Darien High School, will finish out the 1979-80 term as Southern Section Chairman with elections being held in the spring of 1980.

PART II: THE STATE OFFICE

The Theatre Festival

The Drama Contest Series has a new name! THE THEATRE FESTIVAL And a new plan for participation!

The 1979 WHSFA Theatre Festival season should be exciting. Participants can look forward to many changes in this series. Noted below are the major revisions. The Teachers Manual will be more explicit about each of the rule modifications.

- - AN UNGRADED SUBDISTRICT FESTIVAL. You no longer need fear being eliminated at this level. Critiquing and working with play casts will be features of this day. You decide if you want to take part in the District level festival.
- - ELIMINATION OF GRADES ON ALL LEVELS. Three judges will continue to be used from District level on, but they will not give grades. Rather, they will individually decide if they feel your show should be recommended to take part in the next festival level. If two of the three think you have something special started that should have more chance to grow, you will be invited to perform again at the next level. This method will be used all the way to State.
- - AWARDS FOR ALL WHO ARE INVITED TO PARTICIPATE AT THE STATE FESTIVAL. All plays performing at the State Festival will receive an engraved Finalist plaque. Workshops and other activities will be featured for students and directors participation. The focus of this festival will be to share one another's plays with all in attendance without concern about the grade. Judges will be able to give special merit awards for productions they feel are unusually outstanding examples of theatre performances by giving the cast and crew an All-State award. In addition, but completely separate from this award, individual judges may choose to give special merit awards for outstanding acting or directing.
- - CONTINUATION OF A WIDE VARIETY OF THEATRICAL FORMS FOR PRESENTATION. Modification of the critique sheet will now allow judges to comment and use as valid criticism the quality of the various theatrical forms, such as singing and dancing, used as well as their suitability to the production. However, because technical aspects such as sound and lighting are still dependent on the school where the play is performed, they will not be allowable critique items.

All of these changes are the result of the surveys conducted during this past school year. They reflect the desire of the membership to move to an educational festival atmosphere in which students can learn from one another as well as from the festival leaders. The now defined Goals and Objectives for this series reflect this desire also:

- - ASSOCIATION GOALS. 1. To provide a significant training ground for students in the several dramatic arts. 2. To provide multiple opportunities for member schools to view each other's dramatic works.

- - - ASSOCIATION OBJECTIVES. 1. To emphasize actor training, script analysis, and the creative design and use of production elements. 2. To maintain a system of multiple production opportunities grounded in workshop and festival counselling.

WHSFA Junior Division

A major change in the Association is the addition of a division for 6, 7, 8, and 9th grade participation. Junior high teachers, chosen to represent all sections of the state, have been working this past year under the auspices of the WHSFA Board of Control to develop a philosophy of participation for this age group, to determine categories, to write rules and criteria for evaluation, and to organize workshops and festivals for administration, teacher, and student training and participation.

The Division will begin operation this fall with workshops in October for administrator and teacher involvement. These workshops will be for the purpose of explaining the activities and mechanics of this organization.

Membership in this Division is open to any school in Wisconsin which has 6, 7, 8, or 9th grades. If these grade levels are housed in the same building as the 10, 11, and 12th grades and the senior high is a WHSFA member, no additional membership fee will be assessed. If these grade levels are housed in a separate building, or if the senior high does not belong to WHSFA, membership dues of \$50 must be paid. This membership fee will be used to cover the cost of workshops, the Teachers Handbook, and registration fees for the two levels of festivals which the Division will sponsor.

Ninth grade students in a WHSFA member school may participate in either the Junior Division or the Senior Division, but not in both.

The Junior Division is not intended to replace any speech activities in which a school is currently engaged, such as attending tournaments or other speech festivals, but rather to provide an organization for all schools throughout the state to have a program of speech participation for their students.

PART V: PROFESSIONAL INTEREST

ETN Course: "Directing Drama, Debate, and Forensic Programs"

This course is scheduled to begin in October, and continue on a once a month schedule through April. It is a practical, inservice course designed to provide the Intermediate, Junior High, and High School teacher responsible for the Forensic program information and help in conducting Drama, Debate, and Speech activities. The primary objectives of the eight sessions will include theory and practicum in these areas, discussion of particular concerns to the teachers involved, and communication of WHSFA Board of Control activities.

A school fee of \$25 will be charged. For this amount, any number of teachers and community people who are involved in the Forensic program may attend.

Continuing Education Units (CEU's) of up to 1.4 will be available. Individuals may elect to attend only specific sessions as opposed to all, and CEU's will be awarded accordingly.
