PART I: THE BOARD OF CONTROL

WISCONSIN HIGH SCHOOL FORENSIC ASSOCIATION
Minutes of Board of Control Meeting
Pioneer Inn, Oshkosh
May 4-5, 1978

Agenda Item 1

The meeting was called to order by the Chair, George Buckingham, at 7:00 p.m., May 4. Members present, in addition to Buckingham, were:

Armstrong, Beaver, Behnke, Bennett, Bonikowske, Duesterbeck, Goltry (Advisor in Drama), Hintz, Isaacson (Advisor in Speech), Mickolajak, Ott, Renning, Schumacher, Vergin, and Larmer (Secretary-Treasurer).

The meeting was recessed at 9:30 and reconvened at 9:00 a.m. on May 5. All those present on May 4 were in attendance on May 5.

Agenda Item 2

Beaver moved that the minutes of the October 25-26, 1977, Board meeting be approved as distributed. Motion passed.

Agenda Item 3

Larmer distributed framed Certificates of Recognition to retiring Board members Renning and Bonikowske.

Agenda Item 4

- a. Duesterbeck reported on his attendance at the NAEA Committee on Discussion and Debate meeting held in Atlanta during December, 1977.
- b. Larmer announced that the balloting for the Wisconsin Debate Proposition had been completed and that, during 1977-78, Wisconsin high schools will debate the following: "RESOLVED: That the federal government should establish a comprehensive program to significantly increase the energy independence of the United States
- c. Behnke reported for the JR High Membership Committee. The committee will meet again over the summer and will prepare a final report with recommendations at the fall, 1978, Board meeting.
- d. Larmer reported that the WIAA was publishing the 1978-79 joint calendar.
- e. Larmer reported on total membership figures for 1977-78.
- f. Larmer reported on participation figures at the 1977-78 State Contests in Drama, Debate, and Speech.
- g. Larmer reminded Board members that district and sectional financial reports are due in the State Office on July 1, 1978.

- h. Larmer reported on State Office finances and presented a revised four-year budget for the State Office. Armstrong moved adoption of the revised budget. Motion passed.
- i. Larmer reminded Board members of expense reports for the current meeting.
- j. Larmer reported on results to date of pending Board elections. At this point, the procedure for replacing Kenosha District Chair, Richard Sorensen, was discussed. The names Tony Kujawa of Mukwonago and James Highland of Union Grove were offered as possible replacements. Also, since Sorensen's resignation centered around the scheduling of the District Speech Contest, Larmer was asked to prepare an appropriate statement for consideration at the fall Board meeting.
- k. Buckingham reported briefly on his involvement with the WIAA long-range planning committee.
- l. Larmer reported generally on the state of the Association and called on Goltry to report on possible reforms in the State Drama Contest. Vergin moved to endorse the potential reforms in principle and to seek the sentiment of member schools prior to the fall, 1978, Board meeting. Motion passed.
- m. Hintz reported for the Contest Study Committee.
- ** The committee recommended that WHSFA appoint a committee to look into a certification procedure and the clarification of A's, B's, and C's.
- ** The committee reported its judgement that the procedure for disqualification was a minor change and could be included in the 1978-79 Teachers Manual without a membership referendum.
- ** The committee reported its judgement that the obscenity rule could be enacted without a referendum among member schools. However, legal opinion should be sought before enactment.
- ** The committee reported that it took no action on a request to increase set-up time in the Drama contest.
- ** The committee reported that it took no action on a request to reduce the number of contest levels in the Drama contest to three.
- ** The committee recommended--and the Board approved--the designation of a committee of Duesterbeck and Larmer to look into the qualification procedures for the two-speaker division of the State Debate Tournament.

- ** The committee recommended--and the Board approved--adoption in principle of the following statement on weather conditions regarding the State Debate Tournament. The opinion of member Debate schools is to be sought prior to the next Board meeting.

"The WHSFA State Debate Tournament will be held on the announced dates if at all possible. In the event that severe weather problems prevent schools from attending, the starting time of each division of the tournament may be delayed no more than twenty-four hours beyond the announced starting time. Schools arriving after the delayed starting time may participate in the tournament, but will forfeit any rounds missed. If, in the judgement of the tournament director, the number of schools able to attend in either or both divisions is insufficient to hold the tournament, the tournament will be cancelled rather than postponed. Under severe weather conditions, local schools must ultimately decide whether to risk travel or withdraw from the tournament."
- ** The committee recommended that the policy of paying high school coaches attending the State Debate Tournament for their judging stay as it is--i.e., they are expected to judge without pay. The Board recommended that a statement be drafted which would perhaps enable such coaches-judges to be paid under extreme circumstances. The statement is to be reviewed at the next Board meeting.
- ** The committee recommended that the Debate ethics statement be adopted. Bennett moved the adoption. Motion passed.
- ** The committee recommended dropping the "school award" idea at the State Speech Contest. The Board concurred. Ott moved that district chairs be permitted to give special awards not provided for in Association regulations. Motion failed.
- ** The committee reported that suggestions for Public Address topics had not been received in time for consideration. Larmer and Hintz are to write the Public Address topics for 1978-79.
- ** The committee reported that revisions in Play Acting and Interpretive Theatre rules had resulted in the omission of the provision for substitution. Duesterbeck moved that the rules be revised to permit substitution. Motion passed.
- ** The committee reported that rule #1 in Oratory needed revision. Isaacson and the new Central Section Chair were designated to revise the rule.
- ** The committee recommended and the Board concurred that a statement providing for the participation of exceptional students in WHSFA contests be drafted and considered at the next Board meeting.

- ** The committee recommended retaining Interpreter's Theatre as a contest category. Beaver so moved. Motion passed.
- ** The committee recommended increasing the size of subdistrict contests in Speech. Vergin moved that rules be revised to indicate a maximum of six schools in Drama subdistricts and a maximum of twelve schools in Speech subdistricts. Motion passed.

Agenda Item 5

- a. Ott moved adoption of five-year calendar. Motion passed.
- b. Vergin moved that Buckingham represent the Board in the audit of the State Office finances for 1977-78. Motion passed.
- c. Behnke moved that the 1978 fall Board meeting be held on October 24 and 25 in Stevens Point (1st choice) or Wausau (2nd choice). Motion passed. (NOTE: This action creates an automatic revision in the five-year calendar as previously passed.)
- d. The Board heard a presentation by Thomas Tadych of Medalcraft, Incorporated regarding WHSFA awards. Vergin moved that Buckingham and Larmer locate the most feasible supplier of WHSFA awards and negotiate a contract. Motion passed.
- e. Duesterbeck moved that the steps necessary for determining a forfeit in Debate due to tardiness be undertaken at the time and place of the contest. Motion passed.

Agenda Item 6

The meeting was adjourned at noon on May 5, 1978.

1978 Elections

During April and May of 1978, elections were held for four WHSFA district chairpersons and one sectional chairperson: Green Bay District, Glen Snyder, Green Bay Preble High School; Oshkosh District, William Ott, Menasha Butte Des Morts JR High School; Platteville District, Robert Beaver, South Wayne Black Hawk High School; Whitewater District, George Buckingham, Whitewater High School; Central Section, Ron Steinhorst, New London High School. A replacement is yet to be made for Mr. Sorensen of the Kenosha District.

1979 Elections

In the spring of 1979, the State Office will conduct elections for chairpersons of the Kenosha District, the Stevens Point District, the Northern Section, and for our Drama and Speech Advisors.

PART V: PROFESSIONAL INTEREST

WHSFA DRAMA CONTEST REFORM

The validity of any WHSFA activity involving students and teachers should be examined continually. To maintain a program's integrity, change is often desirable. So it is with the WHSFA Drama Contest. Change, however, must be carefully considered to ensure that the results are an improvement in meeting the stated objectives. Since January of 1978, the WHSFA Board of Control and Tom Goltry, Advisor in Drama, assisted by officers from WTA, WSSTA and high school drama directors, have been developing possible reforms that hopefully would bring about desirable results.

This group's concern was whether the contest series fulfilled appropriate educational objectives and accurately reflected the Association's attitude toward competition and achievement. More specifically, current subdistrict elimination procedures, selection of materials, and adequate judging standards were questioned. Also, Association support of the Drama program in terms of promotion and assistance and possible consideration of festivals as alternatives to contests were discussed.

The following goals, objective and rule changes were suggested and in general were acceptable to those teachers attending the WTA convention held in April and also to the WHSFA Board of Control at the May meeting. A questionnaire involving these suggested reforms will be mailed to the member schools for the purpose of reaching agreement on what course of action the WHSFA should take in creating change.

Suggested overall goals for the Association include: (1) to conduct the major interschool speech communication and theater program in the state; (2) to provide a significant educational co-curricular experience in speech communication and theater for all qualified high school students in the state; (3) to insure all students an equal opportunity of access to trained teachers and coaches in Drama, Debate and Individual Speech activities.

Specific goals for the Drama contest would include: (1) to provide a significant training ground for students in the dramatic arts; (2) to provide multiple opportunities for member schools to view each other's dramatic works.

To meet these goals, objectives for drama would then include: (1) development of skills in oral language and all expressive mechanisms and in the understanding of psychological, moral, physical and socio-economic analysis of character as well as elements of stagecraft and production; (2) development of understandings through

investigation of literature, history, divergent societies and cultures, and Drama as a social force, appreciation of an aesthetic and intellectual activity; and learning the channels for creative dramatic work through original productions and alternative forms of theatrical expression; (3) development of opportunities for leadership and group participation, interaction among students in the context of a social and intellectual activity, and promotion of school-community relations through a display of a school's intellectual and artistic work and to develop life-long recreational outlets.

Rule changes that would compliment these goals and objectives to create a learning experience will necessarily center on such items as play choice and the manner of the evaluation of productions. While current Drama rules 1, 2, 4, 6, 7, 8 would remain unchanged, the following rule changes and additions are envisioned.

Rule 3. The choice of script is an important element in determining your group's success. This choice may be subject to critique. Production groups and directors may send their play scripts to the advisor in Drama for counsel and advice. This service is also extended to authors of original works. Such advice is not binding on the director and might not be agreed with by subsequent judges.

Rule 5. The Association recognizes the value in encouraging a rich variety of theatrical productions throughout the state. The burden a director and cast may assume in the various types of theater are of equal value. The major focus must be on skillfully presenting to the audience the understanding of the purpose and nature of the theatrical work by employing the appropriate theatrical means.

Rule 9. All schools choosing to enter the contest must participate in a subdistrict non-graded festival-workshop. Plays will be critiqued at this level and counseling in blocking, interpretation and creative production will be offered. A director may choose to participate in the district level contest if desired. All schools are urged to stay for the entire festival and to participate in all critique sessions.

Rule 10. Schools will be rated on the district level on an advance-stop basis, with no limitations placed on the number of plays which may be advanced. Those schools receiving an "advance" rating from at least two of the judges are eligible to participate in a sectional festival or contest if they so desire. The director may choose to pass the subdistrict critique sheet on to the district judges.

Rule 11. Schools will be rated at sectional level on an advance-stop basis with no limitations on the number of plays which may be advanced. Those schools receiving at least two advance ratings are eligible to participate in the state festival should they desire.

Rule 12. The state festival will have two categories of evaluation: "Finalist" available to each play by their attendance at state, and an "All State Award" extended to those plays deemed deserving by at least two of the judges. In addition, an individual judge can grant awards of special merit for what is deemed outstanding acting or directing. (With rule change 12, gold medals would be granted to individuals in "All State" plays.)

The obvious problems of large numbers of plays from subdistrict level on would hopefully be solved by multiple sites for district and sectional contests and perhaps a lengthier festival at the state level.

The drama critique sheet should reflect these rule changes by indicating the recommendation for advancement rather than "A, B, C" ratings. Also, asking the judge to give consideration to the following factors will emphasize the educational aspects of this event.

1. Does the production indicate understanding of the purpose and nature of the theatrical work?
2. Are acting and production styles suitable for the production?
3. Are theatrical skills--such as character analysis, voice, movement, singing, dancing--well executed by the individuals?
4. Is the production generally effective (remember that lighting, sound, and stage consideration such as usable space, sightlines, and configurations are determined by the available facilities of the host school)?

Any reforms are only justifiable if they improve the quality of the entire contest series. This was the intent of the efforts of the group in re-focusing the Association goals for the Drama contest. Your careful consideration of this material for evaluation and recommendation is encouraged.
