PART I: THE BOARD OF CONTROL

May Board Meeting

The regular meeting of the WHSFA Board of Control was held on May 5-6, 1977, at the Hilton Hotel in Eau Claire.

Agenda Item 1

The meeting was called to order by the chair, George Buckingham, at 7:00 PM. Members present, in addition to Buckingham, were: Frank Cirilli, Raymond Behnke, Bernard Bennett, Dennis Bonikowske, R. M. Duesterbeck, Thomas Goltry (Advisor in Drama), Wayne Gustafson, John Hahn, William Hintz, Pauline Isaacson (Advisor in Speech), William O'Brien, Ed Sievers, Richard Sorensen, Robert Beaver, Edsel Vergin, and Larry Larmer (Secretary-Treasurer). Present also as a guest was Ray Mickolajak from Maple Northwestern High School.

The meeting recessed at 9:15 PM and reconvened at 9:15 AM on May 6. All those present on May 5 were in attendance May 6.

Agenda Item 2

Beaver moved that the minutes of the November 4-5, 1976, meeting be approved as distributed. Motion passed.

Agenda Item 3

Larmer presented, on behalf of the Association, certificates of service to retiring Board members Hahn and Gustafson and a plaque honoring retiring member Frank Cirilli's ten years of service to the Association.

Agenda Item 4a

Duesterbeck reported on his attendance at the NUEA Committee on Discussion and Debate meeting in December, 1976.

Agenda Item 4b

Larmer reported on the balloting for Wisconsin's Debate proposition selection for the 1977-78 school year.

Agenda Item 4c

Larmer reported that he would remind Dick Gaarder of the WSMA that the Wisconsin School Music Association should prepare the joint calendar for distribution to member schools of the WHSFA, WSMA, and WIAA.

Agenda Item 4d

Larmer reported a summary of the Association's income and expenses as of April 26, 1977.

Agenda Item 4e

Larmer reported that the Association's total membership was 470 schools for 1976-77.

Agenda Item 4f

Larmer reported on participation in state Drama, state Debate, and state Speech throughout the Association's history, including 1977-78. It was recommended that a breakdown of state Speech participation be presented at the next meeting which would show the distribution of "A" awards by geography, school size, and contest category.

Agenda Item 4g

Larmer reminded district and section chairs to submit financial reports to the State Office after July 1, 1977.

Agenda Item 4h

Larmer reminded Board members to submit mileage-expense reports for the current meeting.

Agenda Item 4i

Larmer reported on the interim returns of district and section chairperson elections.

Agenda Item 4j

Hintz reported for the JR high festivals conducted on March 19, 1977. Beaver moved that the Association again sponsor such events during the 1977-78 year. Motion passed.

Agenda Item 4k

Cirilli reported for the Ad Hoc Finance Committee which presented three recommendations.

Vergin moved the Committee's recommendation of a five-year budget which redefined the dues structure and rates so that member schools with 200 or fewer students would pay \$70 annually and those with 201 and above would pay \$80 annually. Motion passed. It was subsequently passed to increase the expense item "Secretary-Treasurer" travel to \$2,200.

Hintz moved the Committee recommendation that a special JR high membership category not be established. Motion passed.

Sorensen moved the Committee recommendation that every district or section treasury showing a balance of over \$500 in its 1980 report be required to send the amount in excess of \$500 to the State Office. Motion passed.

Agenda Item 4l

Hintz reported for the Contest Study Committee.

Vergin moved the Committee's recommendation that the 1977-78 Public Address questions be those suggested by Jo Hammers of Wisconsin Dells under the headings of "American Family" and "American Farm." Motion passed.

In response to a desire from several districts that a three-week interval between latest date for subdistrict and district be provided, it was suggested that the impact of such a move on other Associations's calendars be considered at the next Board meeting.

The Committee proposed that no action be taken relative to Significant Speeches even though participation is low in that category.

Duesterbeck moved the Committee's recommendation that the maximum time for Demonstration be ten minutes, including set up and strike down. Motion passed.

The Committee proposed that no action be taken to establish minimum time limits for Speech contest categories.

The Committee chose not to reconsider the dropping of questioning at the end of Extemporaneous Speaking and Demonstration. It was suggested that the reasons for dropping the questioning be made clear in the 1977-78 Teachers Manual.

The Committee recommended that the Association's rule on prompting be made part of the general judge instructions.

Vergin moved the Committee's recommendation that a committee attempt to define what constitutes "A," "B," and "C" ratings in spring Speech.

The Committee recommended that judges be instructed to enforce time-limit rules.

The Committee recommended that no action be taken on the requests that rules requiring changing materials from one contest level to the next be dropped.

The Committee suggested that the committee attempting to define A's, B's, and C's also consider the feasibility of establishing judging certification.

The Committee recommended that the permissible furniture regulation in Play Acting be left as it is.

The Committee recommended and the Board subsequently passed Goltry's revision of Play Acting Rule #3. The revised rule reads, "It is permissible for contestants to play more than one character or for groups to present dramatic material consisting of a series of vignettes. Entrants should be aware, however, that such materials or production styles are subject to critique. Extreme fragmentation of actors into multiple roles may have a severely adverse impact on production effectiveness."

WHSFA Minutes of May 5-6, 1977 Board Cont'd

The Committee recommended and the Board subsequently passed revisions in the Storytelling critique sheet and rules as proposed by Isaacson and Bonikowske. The critique sheet revisions are:

To strike the current criterion #2 and add in its place, "The contestant's ability to reflect the emotional content of the story in facial expression and vocal intonation."

To insert between current criteria 3 and 4 as a new criterion #4, "The contestant's ability to vocalize mimicry, dialect, and other sound effects incorporated into the material."

To insert between current criteria 4 and 5 as a new criterion #6, "The contestant's ability to pace the telling of the story, change tempo, and use pauses effectively."

Current criterion #5 becomes #7.

The rule revisions are:

To revise rule #1 so that the statement pertaining to the introduction reads as follows: "Whether the material is original or not, the contestant shall give a prepared introduction to create the atmosphere and mood of the story."

To add to rule #1 the following sentence: "It is suggested that material take a simple, complete form, deal with universal subject matter, and be written in forceful, pictorial language."

To replace the current rule #5 with the following: "Emphasis should be placed on vocal improvisation of the story, particularly on the pacing of delivery to produce simplicity and directness. The story is to be told in the contestant's own words."

Isaacson and Bonikowske also suggested that a passage from Ruth Sawyer's The Way of the Storyteller be quoted in the Teachers Manual as a way of suggesting Storytelling preparation which does not emphasize memorization.

The Committee stressed that schools must differentiate on the eligibility forms their Play Acting and Interpreter's Theatre entries.

The Committee affirmed that it is permissible to change Interpreter's Theatre material from one contest level to the next if a school so chooses.

In an attempt to clarify what constitutes a script for Interpreter's Theatre, the Committee recommended, and the Board subsequently approved, Goltry's revision of Interpreter's Theatre rule #2. The revised rule is: "The script may be a cutting or a complete work, or a 'compiled' script from various sources, with appropriate introductions and transitions added by the compiler. The material may be prose, poetry, or essay. If a work appears in more than one form, such as a published play script adapted from a novel or vice versa, it must be clear that the nonplay version is the one being presented. The purpose of excluding drama is to most clearly differentiate this contest from the Play Acting contest."

WHSFA Minutes of May 5-6, 1977 Board Cont'd

In an attempt to clarify appropriate use of scripts in Interpreter's Theatre, the Committee recommended, and the Board subsequently approved, Goltry's revision of Interpreter's Theatre rule #4. The revised rule is: "In its presentation, each performance group must clearly show how it intends to use the visible manuscripts or books. This includes the degree of memorization as well as the physical handling of the scripts. Once the conventions for handling scripts are established, all participants in the group should adhere to them. Entrants must remember that the focus of this contest category is on the oral reader, not the actor. The choices they make concerning handling of the scripts are subject to critique."

Vergin moved the Committee's recommendation that the Association explore the possibilities of an "in-service" meeting of Board members and contest hosts to make WHSFA contests more efficient and more uniform. Motion passed.

Cirilli moved the Committee's recommendation to appoint a committee to study the possibility of extending school awards at the State Speech Contest. Motion passed.

The Committee recommended that no action be taken on a suggestion that an "at-large" qualification procedure be enacted for the State Debate Tournament.

The Committee recommended, and the Board subsequently approved, that the 1978 State Debate Tournament be held at University of Wisconsin-Stevens Point and that invitations from other campuses be solicited for the 1979 tournament.

Duesterbeck moved the Committee's recommendation that the system for alternates in the four-speaker division of the State Debate Tournament so that more than one alternate per side may be used. Motion passed.

The Committee recommended no action on a suggestion that the WHSFA Debate ballot be revised.

Vergin moved the Committee's recommendation that the Secretary-Treasurer prepare a statement of Debate ethics to be reviewed at the next Board meeting.

The Committee recommended that the final round be held in the two-speaker division even if the two qualifying teams are from the same school. The Committee recommended no action on the suggestion that a run-off debate for third place be held.

The Committee recommended that a Referee's Committee composed of Board members be on hand during the State Debate Tournament. Hintz, Vergin, and O'Brien volunteered for the 1978 tournament.

The Committee recommended, and the Board subsequently passed, that the Secretary-Treasurer draft an obscenity rule for the Board's consideration at the next meeting.

Agenda Item 5a

Hintz moved the passage of the five-year calendar with the alteration that the fall Board meeting be held on the Tuesday night and Wednesday morning immediately prior to the fall teachers' meeting.

The Board chose Stevens Point as the site for the fall meeting (October 25, 26, 1977) with Wausau as an alternative location.

Agenda Item 5b

Beaver moved that Buckingham represent the Board at the audit of State Office books. Motion passed.

Agenda Item 5c

The Board appointed Ray Mickolajak of Maple Northwestern High School as a replacement for retiring Board member Cirilli. The Board recommended that the Secretary-Treasurer contact Gordon Mortenson (Menasha Butte des Morts JR High), Michael Towsley (Sheboygan South), or Rich Carlson (Neenah Armstrong) as a possible replacement for retiring Board member Hahn.

Agenda Item 5d

The Board passed a motion that WHSFA medallions be changed from gold and silver to bronze and from charms to pins.

The Board instructed the Secretary-Treasurer to investigate costs of life insurance coverage for Board members who travel on Association business.

The meeting adjourned at 12:30 PM.

1977 Elections

During April and May of 1977, elections were held for four WHSFA district chairpersons and one sectional chairperson: Eau Claire District, Bernard Bennett; La Crosse District, Edwin Sievers; Milwaukee District, Ray Behnke; River Falls District, Noel Schumacher; and the Southern Section, William Hintz. At the May Board meeting the Board appointed Ray Mickolajak of Maple Northwestern as a replacement for retiring Board member Cirilli. Replacements are yet to be made for retiring Board member Hahn, Oshkosh District, and for Mr. O'Brien of the Green Bay District.

1978 Elections

In the spring of 1978, the State Office will conduct elections for chairpersons of the Central Section, the Platteville District, and the Whitewater District.

ANOTHER LOOK AT "THE FUTURE OF FORENSICS IN WISCONSIN"

"Fools rush in where angels fear to tread," is an old saying and, probably, a very wise one. And one must seem foolish indeed to attempt to pick up the gauntlet thrown down by my esteemed friend and debater colleague, Professor Grace Walsh, in her article which appeared in the December 1975 WHSFA Newsletter, especially if one is unschooled in the tactics of debate. So, perhaps rather than considering the following as an attempt to directly rebut her arguments, this article might instead be looked at as "A View from Another Perspective."

In her article "The Future of Forensics in Wisconsin," Miss Walsh advocated change in the structure of the state forensic contest in Wisconsin. She reminisced about the times gone by when the contest was a "very thrilling experience." She lamented the present size of the contest at the state level and three times alluded to the cost factor declaring "It is too expensive." Arguing for more opportunities for evaluation and increased competition, she suggested an interim tournament between the district and the state contests to reduce the number of students participating at the state level. In addition, she advocated a ranking system as well as the present ratings. Championing increased competition, Walsh declared ". . . I have always believed that competition is a great motivator in speech and if the achievement is not significant, I doubt that we can justify the money we are spending in producing so many 'A' winners at state."

As I stated at the outset, I propose to look at the state contest from a different view--that of a teacher of Oral Interpretation and that of a relative newcomer to Wisconsin forensics (compared with Miss Walsh). Like the vast majority of my colleagues teaching Oral Interpretation in colleges and universities today, I strongly believe in the value of noncompetitive festivals, at least in Oral Interpretation at the college level. Yet, since coming to Eau Claire in 1968, I have truly been favorably impressed by many of the forensic events and participants I have seen and judged in WHSFA contests at all levels--sub-district, district, and state. This judging, in addition to interpretation events, has included the fall Drama contest and occasional individual public speaking events. The quality that I have seen in Wisconsin is particularly gratifying when compared with similar high school contests that I have judged in other states.

What seems to make the Wisconsin contests better? While it would be hard to point to any one thing, perhaps it may be traced at least in

part to the motto that provides a guiding philosophy: "Not to defeat each other, but to pace one another on the road to excellence." For some these may be no more than pleasant words. For others it may be a hollow, empty phrase. But for the majority the phrase seems a beacon that not only illuminates the way, but also warns against the pitfalls of the fleeting triumph and the momentary success.

The above motto brings to mind one I was first exposed to some twenty years ago. It is inscribed above the proscenium arch at the Kenneth Sawyer Goodman Memorial Theatre in Chicago, where I began my formal study of theatre. The words were taken from a play by the short-lived Goodman: "You yourselves must set flame to the faggots which you have brought." In the present contest structure in Wisconsin, this seems exactly what is demanded of the student: that rather than the flame being ignited by the impetus of the "Mine is better than yours!" philosophy, the student must reach within himself for the spark that will enkindle his creative fire.

Three things that are part of the present contest structure seem designed to assist the student in his efforts: 1) A critique form which, while providing the judge factors to consider in making his evaluation, provides him ample unstructured space for written comments; 2) Freedom from the necessity of being ranked among his peers; and 3) Opportunity for an oral critique by a qualified critic.

It is this last area that I consider most important and, if changes were to be made in the contest, it is here that I would like to see them. It seems to me that two improvements might be made. First, it should be self-evident that judges at all levels of the Speech Contest, but particularly at the state level, should be competent in the area that they are judging. Unfortunately, finances at present may not always make this possible. Thus, additional money may be needed to insure critics of the highest quality. Second, I long for more time to be made available for the oral critiques. While adequate time is usually available at the state level, this is not always the case at the subdistrict or district level. It seems deeply regrettable when a critic is forced by the pressures of scheduling to shorten his oral critique to a minute or less per student in his round. The learning experience that can take place--if there is adequate time for critiques--cannot be fully measured in dollars and cents. If there is the opportunity for genuine interaction, the experience can be of immense value--to the critic as well as the student.

If both of these elements--competent critics and ample time for oral critiques--could be assured, I would worry little over how many "A" ratings were awarded. For I would feel confident that in Wisconsin we were providing the best possible situation for learning and enjoyment by the students, one that might truly be called "thrilling."
