Introduction/Transitions

Conveying Meaning

Score: 4

a lot of emotion went into this but I sometimes got lost in the motivation for each character's emotion

the shift in tone at the end was very jarring and I was taken out the piece by the unexpectedness of it (see comments in vocal delivery)

the accent was very helpful for differentiating between characters

Vocal Delivery

even with my volume all the way up, it was often difficult to hear what you were saying and I had a very hard time following the story (see comment in conveying meaning)

changes in volume for the speakers helped to signify the varying intensities of each moment

Physical Delivery

I enjoyed how you used stance and posture to create a character and convey some of their emotion

as the piece went on, you were increasingly oriented towards the side, instead of centering on the camera & your audience, causing some of your gestures to get lost
